2 (A) [Unless] IN THIS ARTICLE, UNLESS otherwise expressly provided, any 3 obligation imposed on or right granted to any person automatically is binding on or 4 inures to the benefit of [his] THE assigns, successors, heirs, legatees, and personal 5 representatives OF THAT PERSON.

6 **(B)** [However, this] **THIS** section is not to be construed to create or confer 7 any rights of assignment where none would exist otherwise.
