## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Transportation – Pedestrian Right-of-Way – Parking Lots**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a driver of a vehicle to yield the right-of-way to a  
4 pedestrian in a parking lot.

5 BY adding to

6 Article – Transportation

7 Section 21–512

8 Annotated Code of Maryland

9 (2006 Replacement Volume and 2006 Supplement)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article – Transportation**

13 **21–512.**

14 **A DRIVER OF A VEHICLE SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO A**  
15 **PEDESTRIAN IN A PARKING LOT.**

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
17 October 1, 2007.
