CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County – Metropolitan Commission – Terms of Voting Members**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the term of the voting members of the Metropolitan
4 Commission in St. Mary's County; providing that the terms of certain voting
5 members of the Metropolitan Commission serving on a certain date will expire
6 after a certain number of years; and generally relating to the terms of the voting
7 members of the Metropolitan Commission in St. Mary's County.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 19 – St. Mary's County**

1 A. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this chapter, the
2 sanitary districts created are under the jurisdiction of the Commission of seven (7)
3 voting members and one (1) nonvoting member. Each voting member of the
4 Commission shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's
5 County as follows: one (1) member from each of the first, third, sixth, seventh and
6 eighth districts, one (1) member from the second and ninth election districts and one
7 (1) member from the fourth and fifth election districts. Each voting member shall
8 reside in the election district he represents, be a resident taxpayer of the county and
9 be a qualified voter. The voting members of the Commission shall be appointed for a
10 [three-year] **FIVE-YEAR** term and shall serve until their successors are appointed
11 and have qualified. The nonvoting member of the Commission shall be the
12 Commanding Officer of the Patuxent River Naval Air Station or a designated
13 representative of the Commanding Officer. The nonvoting member shall represent the
14 interests of the United States Navy with respect to the water and sewer services
15 provided by the Commission to the Patuxent River Naval Air Station and the Webster
16 Field Annex. The nonvoting member shall serve until the succeeding Commanding
17 Officer is appointed. If the Commanding Officer designates a representative, the
18 representative shall serve at the pleasure of the Commanding Officer and may be
19 replaced at any time. [Those persons serving as members of the Commission
20 immediately prior to June 1, 1976, shall continue to serve in their respective positions
21 until the expiration of their terms.] **EACH VOTING MEMBER SERVING AS A MEMBER**
22 **OF THE COMMISSION IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO JULY 1, 2007, SHALL CONTINUE**
23 **TO SERVE FOR FIVE YEARS AFTER ~~THE~~ THAT MEMBER'S TERM BEGAN, AT WHICH**
24 **TIME THE TERM SHALL EXPIRE.** As the term of each voting member expires, his
25 successor shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's
26 County. Except for a nonvoting member, any vacancy in the membership of the
27 Commission shall be filled by appointment by the Board of County Commissioners of
28 St. Mary's County for the unexpired term.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
30 June 1, 2007.
