## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Liquor Control Board – Salaries**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the annual salaries of the Chairman and regular  
4 members of the Harford County Liquor Control Board; providing that this Act  
5 does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent Chairman or  
6 regular members of the Board; and generally relating to the Harford County  
7 Liquor Control Board.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages  
10 Section 15–201(h)(2)  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2005 Replacement Volume and 2006 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

16 15–201.

1 (h) Members of the several boards shall receive compensation as follows:

2 (2) In Harford County:

3 (i) The Chairman of the Board shall receive an annual  
4 compensation of [~~\$4,500~~] **\$7,000**;

5 (ii) Each member of the Board shall receive an annual  
6 compensation of [~~\$4,000~~] **\$6,000**; and

7 (iii) The Chairman and each member of the Board shall receive  
8 any additional compensation that the County Council deems appropriate.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §  
10 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to  
11 the salary or compensation of the Chairman or regular members in office on the  
12 effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or  
13 compensation of the Chairman or regular members shall take effect at the beginning  
14 of the next following term of office.

15 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
16 July 1, 2007.
