## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning
Sales and Use Tax - Thoroughbred Race Horses - Maryland-Bred Race Fund
FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to distribute the sales and use tax revenue collected on certain sales of thoroughbred race horses to a certain special fund; and generally relating to the sales and use tax revenue collected on certain sales of thoroughbred race horses.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

AFTER MAKING THE DISTRIBUTIONS REQUIRED UNDER §§ 2-1301 THROUGH 2-1302.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE COMPTROLLER QUARTERLY SHALL DISTRIBUTE TO THE MARYLAND-BRED RACE FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 11-530 OF THE BUSINESS Regulation Article the sales and use tax COLLECTED ON THE SALE OF THOROUGHBRED RACE HORSES AT A CLAIMING RACE, WITHIN THE MEANING OF COMAR 09.10.01.07, AS DETERMINED BY THE COMPTROLLER FROM THE BEST INFORMATION AVAILABLE.

After making the distributions required under §§ 2-1301 through [2-1302.1] 2-1302.2 of this subtitle, the Comptroller shall pay:
(1) revenues from the hotel surcharge into the Dorchester County Economic Development Fund established under Article 83A, §5-216 of the Code; and
(2) the remaining sales and use tax revenue into the General Fund of the State.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
