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SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 1 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 Article 20B - Tri-County Council for the Lower Eastern Shore of Maryland 2-101.4 5 (a) The membership of the Council consists of: 6 (1)Five county commissioners of Somerset County as voting members; 7 (2)Five county commissioners of Worcester County as voting members; 8 9 [Five] THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND FOUR county council (3)members of Wicomico County as voting members; 10 11 (4)(i) Three municipal elected officials, one from each county, appointed by their respective municipal corporations as voting members; or 12 If the municipal corporations located within a county are 13 (ii) unable to choose a municipal elected official within a reasonable period of time, the 14 Eastern Shore Municipal Association shall appoint an elected municipal official to 15 16 represent the municipal corporations of that county; 17 (5)Members of the General Assembly representing the region who have a majority of their legislative district in the region as voting ex officio members; 18 19 (6) Other members of the General Assembly representing the region 20 but who do not have a majority of their legislative district in the region as nonvoting 21 ex officio members; and The other commissioners as ex officio nonvoting members. 22 (7)A voting commissioner listed under subsection (a)(1) through (3) of 23 (b) (1)24 section may designate another commissioner or county administrator this 25 representing the same county to vote by proxy on behalf of the voting commissioner when the voting commissioner is absent from a meeting. 26 27 (2)A voting commissioner listed under subsection (a)(1) through (3) of this section shall inform the [council] **COUNCIL** director in advance of which other 28

1 [council] **COUNCIL** member the voting commissioner designates to cast a proxy vote 2 on behalf of the voting commissioner.

3 (c) The bylaws of the Council may provide for additional private citizen 4 membership on the Council.

6 (a) A member who holds membership by virtue of the member's elected 7 position holds office only during the member's term of office.

8 (b) Membership on the Council does not constitute holding an office of profit.
