Conroy Memorial Scholarship Program -**Eligibility** FOR the purpose of altering the eligibility requirements for the Edward T. Conroy Memorial Scholarship Program to include a certain student who is a son, daughter, or surviving spouse of a State or local public safety employee killed in the line of duty to specify that the student may be a resident of any state; providing for the effective date of certain provisions of this Act; providing for the termination of certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to eligibility for the Edward T. Conroy Memorial Scholarship Program. BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Education Section 18-601(a)(1) and (4), (b), and (c)Annotated Code of Maryland (2006 Replacement Volume) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Education Section 18–601(d) Annotated Code of Maryland

If that termination provision takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. This Act may not be interpreted to have any effect on that termination provision.
