- 1 (a) The provisions of this section apply only in Frederick County.
- 2 (f) (1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this [section] **SECTION,**3 wine may be sold as provided under a winery license, a limited winery license, or a
 4 Class A light wine license in any election district.
- 5 (2) A HOLDER OF A LIMITED WINERY LICENSE MAY PROVIDE
 6 TABLES AND CHAIRS ON THE PREMISES OF THE LICENSED FACILITY FOR THE
 7 SALE, BY THE GLASS, OF WINE AND POMACE BRANDY MADE AT THE FACILITY TO
 8 A PERSON WHO PARTICIPATES IN A GUIDED TOUR OF THE FACILITY.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 July 1, 2007.
