## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Tables and Chairs at Wineries**

3 FOR the purpose of allowing in Frederick County a holder of a limited winery license  
4 to provide tables and chairs on the premises of the licensed facility for the sale,  
5 by the glass, of wine and pomace brandy made at the facility to a person who  
6 participates in a guided tour of the facility or attends a certain activity at the  
7 licensed premises; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Frederick  
8 County.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

4 8–211.

5 (a) The provisions of this section apply only in Frederick County.

6 (f) (1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this [section] SECTION,  
7 wine may be sold as provided under a winery license, a limited winery license, or a  
8 Class A light wine license in any election district.

9 (2) **A HOLDER OF A LIMITED WINERY LICENSE MAY PROVIDE**  
10 **TABLES AND CHAIRS ON THE PREMISES OF THE LICENSED FACILITY FOR THE**  
11 **SALE, BY THE GLASS, OF WINE AND POMACE BRANDY MADE AT THE FACILITY TO**  
12 **A PERSON WHO PARTICIPATES IN A GUIDED TOUR OF THE FACILITY OR ATTENDS**  
13 **A SCHEDULED PROMOTIONAL EVENT OR OTHER ORGANIZED ACTIVITY AT THE**  
14 **LICENSED PREMISES.**

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
16 July 1, 2007.
