Worcester County - Sheriff's Office - Personnel Policies

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a certain minimum annual salary for the Sheriff of 4 Worcester County; authorizing the Sheriff to appoint certain employees; 5 requiring the County Commissioners of Worcester County to pay certain 6 expenses of the Sheriff's Office; providing that the chief deputy sheriff serves at 7 the pleasure of the Sheriff; requiring that a certain person who serves as chief 8 deputy sheriff revert to a certain status upon removal; providing that certain 9 personnel rules and regulations of Worcester County apply to certain employees 10 of the Sheriff's Office, authorizing the Sheriff to adopt certain rules for 11 employees of the Sheriff's Office; providing that certain employees of the Sheriff's Office may be disciplined or terminated for cause only in accordance 12 with certain policies; requiring that certain employees of the Sheriff's Office be 13 reappointed at certain times; authorizing the County Commissioners to provide 14 certain support to the Sheriff relating to personnel matters; granting the Sheriff 15 control over the employees of the Sheriff's Office, subject to certain limitations; 16 17 providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent Sheriff of Worcester County; and generally relating to the personnel 18 policies of the Sheriff's Office of Worcester County. 19

- 14 (9) THE SHERIFF SHALL HAVE COMPLETE CONTROL OVER THE
- 15 EMPLOYEES OF THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE, SUBJECT ONLY TO THE PROVISIONS OF
- 16 THIS SUBSECTION AND THE REASONABLE APPLICATION OF THE PERSONNEL
- 17 RULES AND REGULATIONS OF WORCESTER COUNTY AND THE PROTECTIONS
- 18 AND BENEFITS THOSE POLICIES PROVIDE.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
- 20 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
- 21 the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Worcester County in office on the effective
- date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of
- 23 the Sheriff of Worcester County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following
- term of office.
