13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – Tax – Property

16 **7–242.**

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "BUSINESS INCUBATOR" MEANS A PROGRAM IN
 WHICH UNITS OF SPACE ARE LEASED BY MULTIPLE EARLY-STAGE BUSINESSES
 THAT SHARE PHYSICAL COMMON SPACE, ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND

EQUIPMENT, BUSINESS MANAGEMENT TRAINING, MENTORING, AND TECHNICAL

(B) PROPERTY THAT IS USED AS A BUSINESS INCUBATOR IS NOT
SUBJECT TO PROPERTY TAX IF THE STATE, A COUNTY, A MUNICIPAL
CORPORATION, A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION, OR AN AGENCY
OR INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE STATE, A COUNTY, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION,
OR A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION:

8 (1) OWNS, CONTROLS, OR LEASES THE SPACE THAT IS USED AS A
9 BUSINESS INCUBATOR;

10(2)PROVIDES AT LEAST 50% OF THE TOTAL FUNDING RECEIVED11BY THE BUSINESS INCUBATOR FROM ALL SOURCES, NOT INCLUDING RENTS12RECEIVED FROM INCUBATOR TENANT FIRMS; OR

13(3) IS REPRESENTED ON THE GOVERNANCE BOARD THAT14AUTHORIZES THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE BUSINESS INCUBATOR.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 June 1, 2007, and shall be applicable to taxable years beginning after June 30, 2007.
