- 23 **(2)** PROVIDES AT LEAST 50% OF THE TOTAL FUNDING RECEIVED
  24 BY THE BUSINESS INCUBATOR FROM ALL SOURCES, NOT INCLUDING RENTS
  25 RECEIVED FROM INCUBATOR TENANT FIRMS; OR
- 26 (3) IS REPRESENTED ON THE GOVERNANCE BOARD THAT 27 AUTHORIZES THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE BUSINESS INCUBATOR.
- 28 (C) THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY OR THE
  29 GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY PROVIDE,
