A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Lottery Agency to distribute certain lottery proceeds to all the public school systems in the State rather than into the 4 5 General Fund of the State; requiring that public school systems use the money that is distributed for a certain purpose; specifying that the money distributed 6 7 under this Act is intended to provide additional revenue for public school 8 systems and may not supplant any other appropriation to public school systems; 9 defining a certain term; and generally relating to the distribution of lottery 10 proceeds to public school systems in the State.

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 3 (b) (1) In this subsection, "Public school system" means the 4 Collection of Public Elementary and Secondary Education schools
- 5 UNDER THE CONTROL OF A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE BOARD OF
- 6 SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE CITY.
- 7 [(1)] **(2)** Promptly after the 1st day of each month, the Comptroller 8 shall pay:
- 9 (i) into the Maryland Stadium Facilities Fund the money that 10 remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of the sports lotteries conducted 11 for the benefit of the Maryland Stadium Authority, after the distribution under 12 subsection (a) of this section; and
- 13 (ii) [into the General Fund of the State] SUBJECT TO § 9–120.2
 14 OF THIS SUBTITLE, TO ALL THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS IN THE STATE, the
 15 money that remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of all other lotteries
 16 after the distribution under subsection (a) of this section.

- 21 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM" MEANS THE 22 COLLECTION OF PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION SCHOOLS 23 UNDER THE CONTROL OF A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE BOARD OF 24 SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE CITY.
- 25 (B) THE SHARE OF PROCEEDS TO WHICH AN INDIVIDUAL PUBLIC
 26 SCHOOL SYSTEM IS ENTITLED UNDER THE DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENT UNDER
 27 § 9–120(B)(2)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE PROPORTIONATE TO THE
 28 AMOUNT OF SALES OF LOTTERY TICKETS MADE IN THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION

- 30 (C) A PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL USE THE MONEY DISTRIBUTED UNDER § 9–120(B)(2)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR OPERATIONAL EXPENSES.

- 1 (D) A DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 9–120(B)(2)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE IS
 2 INTENDED TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REVENUE FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS
 3 AND MAY NOT SUPPLANT ANY OTHER DISTRIBUTION OF LOTTERY PROCEEDS TO
 4 PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2007.
