A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Charles County – Alcoholic Beverages – Sales to Underage Persons**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the maximum fine that the Board of License
4 Commissioners of Charles County may impose on an employee of an alcoholic
5 beverages licensee for the sale of alcoholic beverages to an underage person; and
6 generally relating to alcoholic beverages sales in Charles County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

15 16–507.

16 (j) (2) (ii) In Charles County, if an employee of an alcoholic beverages
17 licensee sells alcoholic beverages to a person under 21 years of age, the Board of
18 License Commissioners may impose a fine on the employee not to exceed [~~\$50~~] **\$150**
19 per offense.
