A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County – School Board – Elected Members

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that the members of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education be elected; establishing a procedure for the election of members of the 4 5 Anne Arundel County Board of Education from certain districts; establishing a certain term of office for elected members and staggering the terms of the 6 7 members; providing for the removal of members under certain circumstances; 8 providing for a voting student member and for the selection of the student 9 member; providing a procedure for filling a vacancy on the County Board; 10 providing for the election of the president and vice president of the County Board; providing for the compensation of the members of the County Board; 11 12 requiring the County Board to meet at certain intervals; specifying that certain powers and duties of the County Board be exercised by a supermajority of its 13 14 members; submitting this Act to a referendum of the legally qualified voters of Anne Arundel County; providing for the effective date of certain provisions of 15 this Act; and generally relating to the Anne Arundel County Board of 16 17 Education.

10(A) THE STATE BOARD MAY REMOVE A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY11BOARD FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

- 12 (1) **IMMORALITY;**
- 13 (2) MISCONDUCT IN OFFICE;
- 14 **(3) INCOMPETENCY;**
- 15 (4) WILLFUL NEGLECT OF DUTY; OR

16 (5) FAILURE TO ATTEND, WITHOUT GOOD CAUSE, AT LEAST 75%

 MEMBER AN OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A HEARING WITHIN 10 DAYS.

22 (C) IF THE MEMBER REQUESTS A HEARING WITHIN THE 10-DAY 23 PERIOD:

(1) THE STATE BOARD SHALL PROMPTLY HOLD A HEARING, BUT
 A HEARING MAY NOT BE SET WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER THE STATE BOARD SENDS

17 AT ITS FIRST MEETING ON OR AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY IN DECEMBER 18 EACH YEAR, THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL ELECT A PRESIDENT AND VICE 19 PRESIDENT.

(A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, EACH MEMBER OF
 THE COUNTY BOARD IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE ANNUAL COMPENSATION AS

6 (A) THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE EACH MONTH.

(B) THE POWERS AND DUTIES ASSIGNED TO THE COUNTY BOARD
8 SHALL BE EXERCISED IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE BY A
9 SUPERMAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD.

10 (C) EXCEPT FOR THOSE ACTIONS AUTHORIZED BY SUBSECTION (D) OF 11 THIS SECTION, ALL ACTIONS OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE TAKEN AT A 12 PUBLIC MEETING AND A RECORD OF THE MEETING AND ALL ACTIONS SHALL BE 13 MADE PUBLIC.

14(D) THE COUNTY BOARD MAY TAKE ACTIONS IN EXECUTIVE SESSION IN15ACCORDANCE WITH § 10–508 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the 17 appointed members of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education shall expire as 18 follows:

(a) The term of the appointed members from Legislative Districts 30 and 31
scheduled to expire on June 30, 2010, and the term of the appointed member at-large
who has served on the County Board for the longest period shall each terminate on the
first Monday in December 2010 on the taking of office of the elected members from
councilmanic districts 2, 3, and 6; and

(b) The term of the appointed members from Legislative Districts 32 and 33 scheduled to expire on June 30, 2012, and the term of the two remaining appointed members of the County Board shall each terminate on the first Monday in December 27 2012 on the taking of office of the elected members from councilmanic districts 1, 4, 5, and 7.

29 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That before Sections 1 and 2 30 of this Act become effective, this Act shall first be submitted to a referendum of the 31 legally qualified voters of Anne Arundel County at the general election to be held in 32 November of 2008. The County governing body and the Anne Arundel County Board

of Elections shall do those things necessary and proper to provide for and hold the 1 referendum required by this section. There shall be printed on the ballot to be used at 2 3 this election the title of this Act and underneath the title, on separate lines, a square 4 or box opposite the words "For a Board of Education Elected by the Voters of Anne 5 Arundel County" and a corresponding square or box opposite the words "For a Board of Education Appointed by the Governor". A voter may choose only one of the methods of 6 7 selection. If a majority of the votes cast on the question are "For a Board of Education Elected by the Voters of Anne Arundel County", Sections 1 and 2 of this Act shall 8 9 become effective on the 30th day following the official canvass of the votes for the referendum, but if a majority of the votes cast on the question are "For a Board of 10 Education Appointed by the Governor", the provisions of this Act are of no effect and 11 12 null and void.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions
 of Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
