1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Board of Education – Repeal of Spousal Exclusion**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain prohibition that bars an individual who is
4 married to an administrator or teacher of the Frederick County Board of
5 Education from being elected or serving on the County Board; repealing a
6 certain prohibition that bars an individual who is married to a member of the
7 County Board from being hired as an administrator or teacher by the County
8 Board unless the individual's spouse first resigns from the County Board; and
9 generally relating to the Frederick County Board of Education.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Education**

4 3–5B–01.

5 (a) The Frederick County Board consists of seven members elected from the
6 county at large.

7 [3–5B–02.

8 (a) An individual who is married to an administrator or teacher of the
9 County Board may not be elected to or serve on the County Board.

10 (b) An individual who is married to a member of the County Board may not
11 be hired as an administrator or teacher by the County Board unless the individual’s
12 spouse first resigns from the County Board.]

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 July 1, 2007.
