5 FOR the purpose of increasing the number of assistant State's Attorney positions in
6 the State's Attorney's office for Prince George's County; increasing the
7 maximum salaries of the deputy State's Attorneys, the assistant State's
8 Attorneys, and the administrative assistant in the State's Attorney's office; and
9 generally relating to the composition of and salaries in the office of the State's
10 Attorney for Prince George's County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
