A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Education – Laptop Computer Distribution Program

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Laptop Computer Distribution Program in the Department of Education; providing the purpose of the Program; requiring the 4 5 Department to work with each county to provide certain laptop computers to 6 certain students enrolled in certain public schools; authorizing a county board to 7 opt out of the Program for certain reasons; requiring certain county boards to 8 develop and submit to the Department a certain technology plan that includes 9 certain information; requiring the Department to provide certain funds in a 10 certain amount for the cost of the program in each participating county; requiring certain funding to be included in the Department's annual budget; 11 prohibiting certain appropriations for the Program from supplanting the State 12 share of certain basic expenses; authorizing the State Board of Education to 13 14 adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to the Laptop Computer **Distribution Program.** 15

9 (A) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE 10 PROGRAM FOR EACH COUNTY THAT IS EQUAL TO 70% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE 11 COST OF THE PROGRAM IN THE COUNTY.
