1 AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicle Insurance - Accident Prevention Courses - Discount for Seniors

4 FOR the purpose of requiring an insurer to provide a reduction in rates for motor 5 vehicle personal injury and property damage coverage to an insured who is at least 55 years old and who, within a certain period of time, has completed a 6 7 certain course in accident prevention; providing that this Act does not apply to 8 an insured who attends a course in accident prevention under a court order or 9 as required by the Motor Vehicle Administration for a certain violation; 10 authorizing a certain part of the required course in accident prevention to be an on-line course; requiring the Maryland Insurance Commissioner to adopt 11 certain regulations; and generally relating to reductions in motor vehicle 12 13 insurance rates.
