## Vehicle Laws - Special Disability Plates and Parking Placards

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue a special disability parking placard to a person issued two sets of certain special disability registration plates.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13-616.1.

(a) A person may apply to the Administration for a parking placard on a form provided by the Administration if the applicant:
(1) Is a resident of the State; and
(2) (i) Has a permanent disability as described in § 13-616(b)(1) of this subtitle and as certified by a licensed physician, licensed chiropractor, licensed optometrist, or licensed podiatrist, as defined in § 13-616(a) of this subtitle; or
(ii) Has a permanent disability as described in § 13-616(b)(1)(vi) of this subtitle and as self-certified as provided by § 13-616(b)(2)(iv) of this subtitle.
(c) (1) The Administration may not issue to an applicant:
(i) More than one placard if the applicant requests one set of special registration plates under § 13-616 of this subtitle; or
(ii) More than two placards if the applicant does not request a set of special registration plates under § 13-616 of this subtitle.
(2) [The] ExCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE Administration may not issue to a person issued special vehicle registration plates under § 13-616 of this subtitle a combination of special disability registration plates and placards exceeding two.
(3) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ISSUE ONE PLACARD TO A PERSON ISSUED TWO SETS OF SPECIAL DISABILITY REGISTRATION PLATES UNDER § 13-616 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
