Election Law - Prerecorded Phone Messages - Sponsor Identification

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from failing to ensure that certain messages 4 relating to a candidate, campaign, or political committee meet certain 5 requirements; prohibiting a person from sending a certain message that does not provide a certain telephone number or address contain certain information; 6 providing for certain penalties for willful and knowing violation of the 7 8 requirements of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to identification requirements for prerecorded or artificial phone messages using 9 10 autodialer telephone equipment.

13	(II) DIAL TELEPHONE NUMBERS.
14 15 16	(4) (3) "PRERECORDED TELEPHONE MESSAGE" MEANS A TELEPHONE MESSAGE THAT USES A HUMAN VOICE RECORDED IN ADVANCE OF USE.
17 18 19 20	(B) A PERSON MAY NOT FAIL TO ENSURE THAT AN ARTIFICIAL TELEPHONE MESSAGE OR A PRERECORDED TELEPHONE MESSAGE RELATING TO A CANDIDATE, A PROSPECTIVE CANDIDATE, OR THE APPROVAL OR REJECTION OF A QUESTION.
21 22 23	(1) STATES CLEARLY THE IDENTITY OF THE CANDIDATE, CAMPAIGN, POLITICAL COMMITTEE, OR OTHER PERSON INITIATING THE CALL; AND

3	(D) A PERSON WHO WILLFULLY AND KNOWINGLY VIOLATES THIS
4	SECTION SHALL:
5	(1) PAY A CIVIL PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING TWICE THE AMOUNT
6	ASSESSED FOR VIOLATION OF FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION
7	REGULATIONS UNDER 40 C.F.R. PART 64.1200; AND
8	(2) HAVE THE MATTER ADJUDICATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH §
9	13-604(B) THROUGH (G) OF THIS ARTICLE BE SUBJECT TO THE CIVIL PENALTY
10	PROVISIONS OF THE MARYLAND TELEPHONE CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT.
