## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education – Hot Water Temperature in a Public School Facility**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that a county board of education ensure that the hot  
4 water dispensed in a public school facility under its jurisdiction does not exceed  
5 a certain temperature; providing an exception for a certain part of the public  
6 school facility; and generally relating to the temperature of the hot water  
7 dispensed in a public school facility.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 **7–116.**

17 **(A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE CAFETERIA OR OTHER**  
18 **FOOD PROCESSING AREA IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY.**

19 **(B) A COUNTY BOARD SHALL ENSURE THAT THE HOT WATER SYSTEM**  
20 **INSTALLED IN EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY UNDER ITS JURISDICTION IS**

1 **CONFIGURED AND MAINTAINED IN A MANNER THAT INSURES THAT THE HOT**  
2 **WATER DISPENSED FROM ANY FAUCET, SPIGOT, TAP, OR OTHER OUTLET IN THE**  
3 **FACILITY DOES NOT EXCEED A TEMPERATURE OF 120 DEGREES FAHRENHEIT.**

4           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
5 October 1, 2007.
