13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15		Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages
16	6–711.	
17	(A)	THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CECIL COUNTY.
18	(B)	THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$100.

1 (C) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A CATERER'S 2 LICENSE TO A HOLDER OF:

3 (1) A CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR 4 LICENSE; OR

5 (2) A CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER AND LIGHT WINE 6 LICENSE.

7 (D) A CATERER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO PROVIDE
8 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT EVENTS THAT ARE HELD OFF THE PREMISES FOR
9 WHICH THE CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE
10 OR CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE IS ISSUED.

11 (E) THE HOLDER OF A CATERER'S LICENSE SHALL PROVIDE FOOD AS 12 WELL AS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION AT THE CATERED EVENT.

13 (F) A HOLDER MAY EXERCISE THE PRIVILEGES UNDER A CATERER'S 14 LICENSE ONLY DURING THE DAYS AND HOURS THAT ARE AUTHORIZED UNDER 15 THIS ARTICLE FOR A CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR 16 LICENSE OR A CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER AND LIGHT WINE 17 LICENSE.

18 (G) THIS SECTION DOES NOT REQUIRE A HOLDER OF AN EXISTING 19 CLASS B BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE OR AN EXISTING CLASS B 20 RESTAURANT OR HOTEL BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE TO HAVE A CATERER'S 21 LICENSE FOR CATERING ON THE PREMISES FOR WHICH THE EXISTING LICENSE 22 IS ISSUED.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
24 July 1, 2007.
