- 3 (2) The funeral expenses paid by the local department may not exceed 4 \$900.
- 5 (3) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT SHALL PAY THE FUNERAL EXPENSES UNDER THIS SECTION FOR EACH FUNERAL WITH TOTAL FUNERAL EXPENSES OF \$2,500 OR LESS.
- 8 (b) A local department may not pay funeral expenses under this section 9 unless:
- 10 (1) each person legally responsible for the support of the decedent is 11 unable to pay the expenses; and
- 12 (2) other resources, including available death benefits of the estate, are insufficient to pay the expenses.
- 14 (c) Payments provided in accordance with this section shall be charged to 15 State funds.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
