1 AN ACT concerning

2 Andrew's Law

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to provide for a method by which an applicant for a driver's license or identification card can 4 5 designate an individual to contact in the event the applicant becomes 6 incapacitated; requiring the Administration to make a notation on the applicant's driving record or record of application for an identification card 7 8 indicating the fact that the applicant has designated a certain individual as an 9 emergency contact in the event the applicant becomes incapacitated; requiring the Administration to develop a database system that contains certain 10 11 telephone numbers and is accessible by a law enforcement officer; requiring the 12 Administration to notify an applicant of certain facts; defining a certain term; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to developing a 13 system for designating an individual to contact under certain circumstances. 14

- 5 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "EMERGENCY CONTACT" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL 6 WHO HAS BEEN DESIGNATED BY AN APPLICANT FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR 7 IDENTIFICATION CARD AS A PERSON TO CONTACT IN THE EVENT THE 8 APPLICANT BECOMES INCAPACITATED.
- 9 **(B)** THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROVIDE FOR A METHOD BY WHICH 10 AN APPLICANT FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD MAY 11 DESIGNATE UP TO THREE EMERGENCY CONTACTS.
- 12 (C) IF AN APPLICANT DESIGNATES AN EMERGENCY CONTACT, THE
 13 ADMINISTRATION SHALL MAKE A NOTATION OF THIS FACT ON THE APPLICANT'S
 14 DRIVING RECORD OR RECORD OF APPLICATION FOR AN IDENTIFICATION CARD.
- 15 **(D)** THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:
- 16 **(1) DEVELOP A DATABASE SYSTEM THAT CONTAINS THE**17 **TELEPHONE NUMBERS OF THE APPLICANT'S EMERGENCY CONTACTS; AND**
- 18 **(2) DEVELOP A SYSTEM FOR ALLOWING A LAW ENFORCEMENT**19 **OFFICER TO ACCESS AN EMERGENCY CONTACT TELEPHONE NUMBER THAT IS**20 **STORED IN THE DATABASE SYSTEM.**
- 21 **(E)** AT THE TIME THE APPLICANT DESIGNATES AN EMERGENCY 22 CONTACT, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL NOTIFY THE APPLICANT THAT:
- 23 (1) THE DESIGNATION AUTHORIZES A LAW ENFORCEMENT
 24 OFFICER TO ACCESS THE APPLICANT'S EMERGENCY CONTACT TELEPHONE
 25 NUMBERS; AND
- 26 **(2)** THE DESIGNATION CAN BE REMOVED ONLY AS PROVIDED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 2008.
