- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (a) An individual under the age of 16 years may not ride on a [scooter or on]
 17 **SCOOTER, A SKATEBOARD, OR** in–line skates on any highway, bicycle way, sidewalk,
 18 or other property open to the public or used by the public for pedestrian or vehicular
 19 traffic, unless the individual is wearing a helmet that meets or exceeds the standards
- 20 of the American National Standards Institute, the Snell Memorial Foundation, or the

- American Society of Testing and Measurements for protective headgear for use in bicycling, **RIDING A SKATEBOARD**, or in-line skating.
- 3 (b) This section shall be enforced by the issuance of a warning that informs 4 the offender of the requirements of this section and provides educational materials 5 about helmet use.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2007.
