## A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Vehicle Laws – Drivers of Motor Homes – Driver Licensing Requirements

- FOR the purpose of exempting from certain driver licensing requirements an 3 4 individual who is driving a certain motor home if the individual holds a valid 5 Class C driver's license; making stylistic changes; requiring the Motor Vehicle 6 Administration to study certain issues relating to driver licensing for the 7 operation of motor homes; requiring the Administration to report to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of certain 8 9 provisions of this Act; and generally relating to an exemption from certain driver licensing requirements for certain individuals. 10

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That: 10 The Motor Vehicle Administration shall study issues relating to the (a) licensing of drivers of motor homes, including: 11 12 (1)training; 13 (2)testing; 14 requiring an endorsement for motor homes on a noncommercial (3)Class C driver's license; 15 16 the feasibility of grandfathering licensees who currently drive (4)17 motor homes; and any other issues identified by the Administration. 18 (5)19 On or before December 31, 2007, the Administration shall report its (b) 20 findings to the General Assembly in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State 21 Government Article. SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 June 1, 2007. Section 2 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of 7 months and, 23 at the end of December 31, 2007, with no further action required by the General 24 Assembly, Section 2 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. 25
