FOR the purpose of authorizing, rather than requiring, the county executives of 6 7 Montgomery County and Prince George's County to conduct certain interviews 8 of each applicant for appointment or reappointment to the Washington 9 Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC); requiring the county executives to 10 conduct certain interviews of applicants selected for appointment to the WSSC; authorizing a designee of the County Executive of Montgomery County to 11 require certain applicants to produce certain documents; altering certain 12 requirements relating to the deadline for filing of certain financial disclosure 13 statements filed by certain applicants for appointments to the WSSC and to the 14 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) in 15 16 Montgomery County and Prince George's County; clarifying 17 requirements relating to the content of certain financial disclosure statements filed by certain applicants for appointment to the WSSC and M-NCPPC; 18 19 making stylistic changes; and generally relating to applications for appointments to the WSSC and the M-NCPPC. 20
