A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Automotive Dismantlers and Recyclers and Scrap Processors**
3 **– Notice of Vehicle Acquisition**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain provision of law requiring an automotive
5 dismantler and recycler or scrap processor to provide certain notice to the Motor
6 Vehicle Administration within a certain time period after acquiring title to a
7 vehicle and before disposing of the vehicle for dismantling or scraping; and
8 generally relating to automotive dismantlers and recyclers and scrap
9 processors.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Transportation**

18 [15–508.

19 (a) Within 30 days after an automotive dismantler and recycler or scrap
20 processor acquires title to a vehicle, the automotive dismantler and recycler or scrap
21 processor shall notify the Administration of the acquisition.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (b) The notice shall be given in the form that the Administration requires.

2 (c) Immediately after giving the required notice the automotive dismantler
3 and recycler or scrap processor may dispose of the vehicle for dismantling or
4 scrapping.]

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 June 1, 2007.
