(4) A VOLUNTARY SICKLE CELL DISEASE PATIENT REGISTRY OR
DATABASE; OR
(5) A WEB-BASED REPOSITORY FOR ABBREVIATED ELECTRONIC
MEDICAL RECORDS FOR SICKLE CELL DISEASE PATIENTS.
