1 AN ACT concerning

2 Environment – Outdoor Wood Burning Furnaces – Requirements

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting the use of an outdoor wood burning furnace in a municipality; authorizing the use of an outdoor wood burning furnace outside of a municipality under certain circumstances; prohibiting certain individuals from bringing certain nuisance claims; requiring certain commercial sellers to notify certain buyers of the provisions of this Act; exempting certain individuals from certain provisions of this Act under certain circumstances; defining a certain term; and generally relating to outdoor wood burning furnaces.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19(A) IN THIS SECTION, "OUTDOOR WOOD BURNING FURNACE" MEANS A20FREESTANDING, OUTDOOR, RESIDENTIAL FURNACE THAT:

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



(1) CONSISTS OF A WOOD BURNING FIREBOX SURROUNDED BY A 1 2 WATER RESERVOIR THAT IS VENTED BY A CHIMNEY STACK; AND 3 (2) IS USED TO SUPPLY HEAT, HOT WATER, OR BOTH TO A 4 **RESIDENTIAL DWELLING.** 5 **(B)** AN OUTDOOR WOOD BURNING FURNACE MAY BE USED IF: IT IS LOCATED AND OPERATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH 6 (1) 7 **APPLICABLE LOCAL ORDINANCES;** 8 (2) IT IS LOCATED AT LEAST 200 FEET FROM AN OCCUPIED 9 DWELLING THAT IS NOT SERVICED BY THE OUTDOOR WOOD BURNING FURNACE; 10 AND (3) 11 THE HEIGHT OF THE CHIMNEY STACK IS TALLER THAN THE 12 **ROOF LINE OF THE DWELLING IT SERVES.** 13 (C) A PERSON WHO CONSTRUCTS A NEW RESIDENTIAL DWELLING

14 WITHIN 200 FEET OF AN EXISTING OUTDOOR WOOD BURNING FURNACE MAY
15 NOT BRING A CLAIM OF NUISANCE AGAINST THE OWNER OF THE EXISTING
16 OUTDOOR WOOD BURNING FURNACE.

17 (D) A COMMERCIAL SELLER OF OUTDOOR WOOD BURNING FURNACES
 18 IN THE STATE SHALL NOTIFY BUYERS OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION
 19 BEFORE THE SALE OF AN OUTDOOR WOOD BURNING FURNACE.

(E) SUBSECTION (B)(2) OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A
 PERSON WHO OWNS AN OUTDOOR WOOD BURNING FURNACE ON OR BEFORE
 OCTOBER 1, 2007.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 24 October 1, 2007.
