A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Electricity Suppliers - Sale of Wholesale Electricity to Affiliated Companies and Disclosure of Rates

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain electricity suppliers that are affiliated with an 5 electric company that operates in the State to offer to sell wholesale electricity 6 to the electric company at the lowest best price that it sells electricity to certain 7 other customers; authorizing the Public Service Commission to waive the 8 obligation of a certain electricity supplier to offer to sell wholesale electricity to 9 a certain electric company at the lowest best price if the Commission makes a 10 certain determination under certain circumstances; requiring certain electricity suppliers to disclose to certain persons the rates of all electricity it sells to any 11 12 customer; providing that existing obligations or contract rights may not be impaired by this Act; making the provisions of this Act severable; and generally 13 relating to the disclosure of electricity rates by certain electricity suppliers and 14 the sale of wholesale electricity to electric companies by affiliated electricity 15 16 suppliers.

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, AN
 4 ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER THAT IS AFFILIATED WITH AN ELECTRIC COMPANY
 5 OPERATING IN THE STATE MUST OFFER TO SELL TO THE AFFILIATED ELECTRIC

 12 AT THE LOWEST BEST PRICE UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IF THE
 13 COMMISSION DETERMINES THAT:
- 14 **(1)** THE REQUIREMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION
 15 WILL RESULT IN THE INABILITY OF THE ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER TO MEET

- 17 (2) THE ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER DOES NOT HAVE THE CAPACITY
 18 TO GENERATE, OR THE ABILITY TO PURCHASE, SUFFICIENT ELECTRICITY TO
 19 FILL THE ELECTRICITY NEEDS OF THE AFFILIATED ELECTRIC COMPANY.
- 20 (C) AN ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER THAT IS AFFILIATED WITH AN ELECTRIC
 21 COMPANY THAT OPERATES IN THE STATE SHALL DISCLOSE THE RATES OF ALL
 22 ELECTRICITY THAT IT SELLS TO PERSONS THAT ARE LOCATED IN OR OUTSIDE
 23 THE STATE TO:
- 24 (1) THE COMMISSION;
- 25 (2) THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL; AND
- 26 (3) ANY AFFILIATED ELECTRIC COMPANY THAT OPERATES IN THE 27 STATE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a presently existing obligation or contract right may not be impaired in any way by this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason in a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or any other application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and for this purpose the provisions of this Act are declared severable.

 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
