Education - Character Education Fund

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Character Education Fund; requiring the 4 Governor to include a certain amount in the State budget each fiscal year for 5 the Fund; establishing the grant eligibility requirements for the Fund; requiring the State Department of Education to adopt criteria for approving character 6 7 education programs, decide whether to approve a proposed character education 8 program by certain dates, make certain grant awards to county boards of 9 education with approved character education programs by certain dates and in certain amounts, host a certain conference annually, and establish certain 10 reporting requirements; requiring the Department to report to the Governor 11 and the General Assembly on or before certain dates; expressing the intent of 12 13 the General Assembly that the Department host a certain conference at a 14 certain time; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the Character Education Fund. 15

1 2	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 6	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "FUND" MEANS THE CHARACTER EDUCATION FUND.
7	(B) THERE IS A CHARACTER EDUCATION FUND IN THE DEPARTMENT.
8 9	(C) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO ENCOURAGE COUNTY BOARDS TO FUND AND IMPLEMENT CHARACTER EDUCATION PROGRAMS.
10	(D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.
11 12	(E) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
13 14	(2) THE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
15	(F) (1) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
16 17	(I) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;
18	(II) INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND; AND
19 20	(III) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
21 22	(2) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE \$250,000 IN THE STATE BUDGET EACH FISCAL YEAR FOR THE FUND.
23	(G) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY:

- 1 (1) TO PROVIDE MATCHING GRANTS TO COUNTY BOARDS TO
 2 IMPLEMENT CHARACTER EDUCATION PROGRAMS APPROVED BY THE
 3 DEPARTMENT; AND
- 4 (2) TO PAY UP TO \$25,000 ANNUALLY FOR THE COSTS OF THE 5 ANNUAL CONFERENCE ON CHARACTER EDUCATION BEST PRACTICES, 6 INCLUDING GRANTS TO COUNTY BOARDS TO SEND INDIVIDUALS TO THE ANNUAL
- 7 **CONFERENCE.**

- 8 (H) (1) THE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND IN 9 THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.
- 10 (2) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE 11 CREDITED TO THE FUND.
- 12 (I) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
- 14 (J) TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A GRANT FROM THE FUND, A COUNTY
 15 BOARD SHALL SUBMIT A DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED CHARACTER
 16 EDUCATION PROGRAM TO THE DEPARTMENT BY JUNE 1 PRECEDING THE
 17 SCHOOL YEAR IN WHICH THE CHARACTER EDUCATION PROGRAM WILL BE
 18 IMPLEMENTED.

(K) THE DEPARTMENT:

- 20 **(1)** SHALL ADOPT CRITERIA FOR APPROVING CHARACTER 21 EDUCATION PROGRAMS;
- 22 **(2)** SHALL DECIDE WHETHER TO APPROVE A PROPOSED CHARACTER EDUCATION PROGRAM BY JULY 1 PRECEDING THE SCHOOL YEAR IN WHICH A CHARACTER EDUCATION PROGRAM WILL BE IMPLEMENTED;
- 25 (3) SHALL AWARD, BY JULY 1 PRECEDING THE SCHOOL YEAR IN
 26 WHICH A CHARACTER EDUCATION PROGRAM WILL BE IMPLEMENTED, A GRANT
 27 TO THE FIVE COUNTY BOARDS WITH THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF STUDENT
 28 SUSPENSIONS DURING THE 2005 2006 SCHOOL YEAR AS REPORTED BY THE
 29 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION WITH AN APPROVED CHARACTER EDUCATION
 30 PROGRAM EQUAL TO THE LESSER OF:

3	(II) THE PRODUCT OF THE AMOUNT OF MONEY IN THE
4	FUND AT THE START OF THE FISCAL YEAR AND THE PERCENTAGE OF THE
5	NUMBER OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE ELIGIBLE

8	(4) SHALL ESTABLISH, BY REGULATION, REPORTING
9	REQUIREMENTS FOR COUNTY BOARDS THAT RECEIVE GRANTS FROM THE FUND,
10 11	INCLUDING A REQUIREMENT THAT THE REPORTS PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION REGARDING SCHOOLS IN THE REPORTING COUNTY:
12	(I) ACADEMIC SUCCESS RATES, AS MEASURED BY
13	STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES, COLLEGE ADMISSION RATES, AND OTHER INDICIA
14	OF ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT;
15	(II) TEACHER RETENTION RATES;
16	(III) SCHOOL DROPOUT RATES;
17	(IV) DISCIPLINARY REFERRAL RATES; AND
18	(V) LEVELS OF PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT IN SCHOOL AND
19	STUDENT ACTIVITIES; AND
20	(5) SHALL ANNUALLY HOST THE CONFERENCE ON CHARACTER
21	EDUCATION BEST PRACTICES.
22	(L) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND TO THE
23	GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, IN
24	ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON THE
25	DISTRIBUTION OF GRANTS FROM THE FUND AND THE IMPACT OF THE GRANTS
26	ON CHARACTER EDUCATION IN THE STATE FOR THE PRIOR SCHOOL YEAR.
27	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the
28	General Assembly that the State Department of Education host the first annual
29	Conference on Character Education Best Practices in the fall of 2007.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
