Human Hybridization Prohibition Act of 2007

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from performing certain acts that result in 4 the creation of an embryo with a predominantly or partially human genetic 5 constitution; prohibiting a person from soliciting or knowingly creating or 6 acquiring certain organisms, tissue, or cells; establishing certain criminal 7 penalties; defining certain terms; and generally relating to prohibiting 8 hybridization of humans and nonhumans.

- A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND ON
 CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 10 YEARS OR A
 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$200,000 OR BOTH.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2007.
