SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article - State Personnel and Pensions
25–401.
(a) A member may retire with a normal service retirement allowance if:
(1) on or before the date of retirement, the member has at least 20 years of eligibility service;

2	was a security attendant at Clifton T. Perkins Hospital Center, a correctional officer in

4	(3) the member completes and submits a written application to the

6	(b) On retirement under this section, a member is entitled to receive a
7	normal service retirement allowance that equals [one fifty-fifth] THE SUM OF:
8	(1) 1.8% of the member's average final compensation multiplied by
9	the number of years of creditable service ATTAINED ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2007
10	AND
11	(2) 2.2% OF THE MEMBER'S AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION
12	MULTIPLIED BY THE NUMBER OF YEARS OF CREDITABLE SERVICE ATTAINED ON
13	OR AFTER JULY 1, 2007.
