- 5 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Business and Economic 6 Development to contract with two or more private companies to administer the 7 programs of the Maryland Small Business Development Financing Authority; 8 specifying that, if the Department contracts with companies to administer 9 certain programs, the Department is required to contract with at least one 10 company in the Baltimore metropolitan region and at least one company in the Maryland portion of the Washington metropolitan region and is required to 11 ensure that each company with which it contracts administers all of the 12 programs of the Authority; authorizing the Department to extend and renew 13 14 certain contracts with certain companies under certain circumstances; repealing 15 a certain definition; and generally relating to the Maryland Small Business Development Financing Authority. 16
