Frederick County - Employees' Pension System - Alternate Contributory Pension Selection

- 4 FOR the purpose of allowing the employees of Frederick County who are members of the Employees' Pension System to become subject to the Alternate Contributory 5 Pension Selection that alters the benefits those members receive and requires a 6 7 certain member contribution; authorizing the purchase of service credit under certain circumstances; requiring Frederick County to pay for certain additional 8 9 pension liabilities according to a certain amortization schedule approved by the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension System; making this 10 11 Act subject to a certain contingency; requiring the State Retirement Agency to verify certain information; and generally relating to participation in the 12 Alternate Contributory Pension Selection part of the Employees' Pension 13 System by certain employees of Frederick County. 14

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (k) (1) For each employee who is subject to the contributory pension benefit under Title 23, Subtitle 2, Part II of this article, Frederick County shall pay the additional liabilities that result from the contributory pension benefit according to a schedule of amortization that is subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees.
- 9 (2) FOR EACH EMPLOYEE WHO IS SUBJECT TO THE ALTERNATE
 10 CONTRIBUTORY PENSION SELECTION UNDER TITLE 23, SUBTITLE 2, PART III
 11 OF THIS ARTICLE, FREDERICK COUNTY SHALL PAY THE ADDITIONAL
 12 LIABILITIES THAT RESULT FROM THE ALTERNATE CONTRIBUTORY PENSION

- 16 (a) In this section, "active member" means a member who is not separated 17 from employment with the State or a participating employer of the State.
- 18 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, this part applies to an individual who on or after June 30, 2006, is:
- 20 (1) an active member of the Employees' Pension System or the 21 Teachers' Pension System; or
- 22 (2) a member of the Teachers' Retirement System or Employees' 23 Retirement System who is subject to Selection C (Combination Formula) as provided 24 in § 22–221 of this article.
 - (c) This Part III does not apply to:
- 26 (1) an employee of a participating governmental unit participating in 27 the Employees' Pension System that has not elected to participate in the Alternate 28 Contributory Pension Selection under § 31–116.1 of this article or a former 29 participating governmental unit, OTHER THAN FREDERICK COUNTY, that has 30 withdrawn from the Employees' Pension System; or

- 1 (2) a member of the Employees' Pension System or the Teachers'
- 2 Pension System who transferred from the Employees' Retirement System or the
- 3 Teachers' Retirement System after April 1, 1998.

- 5 (a) This section applies only to a former member, member, retiree, or 6 surviving beneficiary of the Employees' Pension System who, while a member, was an 7 employee of Frederick County.
- 8 (b) Except as provided in subsection [(c)] (**D**) of this section, a member who is subject to the contributory pension benefit under Subtitle 2, Part II of this title may purchase credit for eligibility service for the period of employment from July 1, 1998, through July 1, 2000, by paying to the Board of Trustees:
- 12 (1) on or before June 30, 2001, the amount the member would have 13 been required to contribute for that period of employment; or
- 14 (2) on or after July 1, 2001, the amount the member would have been 15 required to contribute for that period of employment plus regular interest compounded 16 annually.
- 17 (C) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, A
 18 MEMBER WHO IS SUBJECT TO THE ALTERNATE CONTRIBUTORY PENSION
 19 SELECTION UNDER SUBTITLE 2, PART III OF THIS TITLE MAY PURCHASE
 20 CREDIT FOR ELIGIBILITY SERVICE FOR THE PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT FROM
 21 JULY 1, 2006, THROUGH JULY 1, 2007, BY PAYING TO THE BOARD OF
 22 TRUSTEES:
- 23 (1) ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2008, THE AMOUNT THE MEMBER
 24 WOULD HAVE BEEN REQUIRED TO CONTRIBUTE FOR THAT PERIOD OF
 25 EMPLOYMENT; OR
- 26 **(2)** ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2008, THE AMOUNT THE MEMBER 27 WOULD HAVE BEEN REQUIRED TO CONTRIBUTE FOR THAT PERIOD OF 28 EMPLOYMENT PLUS REGULAR INTEREST COMPOUNDED ANNUALLY.
- [(c)] (D) If the member fails to make the payment as provided under subsection (b) OR (C) of this section, the Board of Trustees shall reduce actuarially the allowance payable to a former member, retiree, or surviving beneficiary of a deceased member, former member, or retiree.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 1 2 July 1, 2007, contingent on approval on or before July 1, 2007, by the Board of County 3 Commissioners of Frederick County for the participation of the employees of Frederick 4 County in the Alternate Contributory Pension Selection of the Employees' Pension 5 System under Title 23, Subtitle 2, Part III of the State Personnel and Pensions Article. 6 If the Board of County Commissioners of Frederick County does not approve on or 7 before July 1, 2007, the participation of the employees of Frederick County in the Alternate Contributory Pension Selection of the Employees' Pension System, this Act, 8 9 with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be null and void and of no force and effect. On or before July 15, 2007, the State Retirement Agency shall 10 verify whether the Board of County Commissioners of Frederick County approved on 11 12 or before July 1, 2007, the participation of the employees of Frederick County in the 13 Alternate Contributory Pension Selection of the Employees' Pension System and shall notify in writing the Department of Legislative Services, 90 State Circle, Annapolis, 14 15 Maryland 21401.
