15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE PARENT-TEACHER
20	ASSOCIATION MATCHING FUND PILOT PROGRAM.
21	(B) THERE IS A PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION MATCHING FUND
22	PILOT PROGRAM IN BALTIMORE CITY AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.
23	(C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO:
24	(1) ENCOURAGE PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATIONS TO RAISE
25	FUNDS FOR PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS; AND
26 27	(2) PROVIDE ADDITIONAL STATE FUNDS FOR PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS.
28	(D) THE STATE SHALL PROVIDE A DOLLAR-FOR-DOLLAR MATCH UP TO
29	\$250,000 FOR PRIVATE FUNDS RAISED BY EACH PARENT-TEACHER
30	ASSOCIATION IN A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN BALTIMORE CITY AND PRINCE

1(D)(1)EACH PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN BALTIMORE CITY AND2PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY IS ELIGIBLE FOR A DOLLAR-FOR-DOLLAR MATCH3FOR PRIVATE FUNDS RAISED BY THE SCHOOL'S PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION4UP TO:

5 <u>(I)</u> IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE AMOUNT RAISED BY THE 6 PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION, NOT TO EXCEED THE SCHOOL'S EQUAL SHARE 7 AS DETERMINED BY DIVIDING \$125,000 BY THE NUMBER OF PUBLIC HIGH 8 SCHOOLS IN BALTIMORE CITY; AND

9 (II) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE AMOUNT RAISED
10 BY THE PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION, NOT TO EXCEED THE SCHOOL'S EQUAL
11 SHARE AS DETERMINED BY DIVIDING \$125,000 BY THE NUMBER OF PUBLIC
12 HIGH SCHOOLS IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.

13(2)THE TOTAL AMOUNT EXPENDED UNDER THE PROGRAM MAY14NOT EXCEED \$250,000 \$200,000 ANNUALLY.

15 (E) FUNDS FOR THE PROGRAM SHALL BE AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE 16 BUDGET BY THE GOVERNOR.

17 **(F)** ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE CHIEF **EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM AND** 18 THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SHALL 19 **REPORT TO THE SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE** 20 WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE 21 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON THE STATUS OF, AND THE BENEFITS ACCRUED 22 23 FROM, THE PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION MATCHING FUND PILOT **PROGRAM.** 24

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2007. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of 27 September 30, 2010, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act 28 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
