- 3 (II) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE 4 COVERAGE FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS AND DEVICES UNDER CONTRACTS THAT 5 ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.
- 6 (2) AN INSURER, NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN, OR HEALTH
  7 MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION THAT PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR PRESCRIPTION

  12 DRUG OR DEVICE THAT EXCEEDS THE RETAIL PRICE OF THE PRESCRIPTION
  13 DRUG OR DEVICE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
