- FOR the purpose of requiring the State Superintendent of Schools Department of 4 5 Education, in collaboration with the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, 6 to establish and promote in certain schools a public awareness campaign related 7 to self-injury by cutting; providing for the components of the campaign; 8 authorizing the State Superintendent to use certain resources to carry out the 9 provisions of this Act; provide awareness and training for certain individuals on self-mutilation; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to 10 provide to the State Department of Education certain information and materials 11 on self-mutilation; and generally relating to a public awareness campaign about 12 self-injury by cutting awareness, training, and distribution of materials on 13 14 self-mutilation.
