CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County – Highway User Revenues – Special Taxing Districts**

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying that no provision of law may be construed as prohibiting
4 Calvert County from accepting an easement for public travel on a highway in a
5 special taxing district, including in the county's inventory of county roads any
6 highway in a special taxing district in the county, or distributing a portion of
7 the county's highway user revenues to a special taxing district in the county;
8 clarifying that, for purposes of certain provisions of this Act, a certain highway
9 includes a gravel road; declaring the intent of the General Assembly that
10 Calvert County accept an easement for public travel on all highways in all
11 special taxing districts in the county, include in the county's inventory of county
12 roads all highways in all special taxing districts in the county, and distribute a
13 portion of the county's highway user revenues to all special taxing districts in
14 the county; and generally relating to highway user revenues and special taxing
15 districts in Calvert County.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Transportation**

4 8–404.

5 (a) Highway user revenues shall be allocated to the counties:

6 (1) One half on a county road mileage basis, as provided in subsection
7 (b)(1) of this section; and

8 (2) One half on a motor vehicle registration basis, as provided in
9 subsection (b)(2) of this section.

10 (b) The Administration shall allocate for the account of each county, out of
11 the highway user revenues provided for under § 8–403 of this subtitle, its gross share,
12 to be determined by adding:

13 (1) The amount that results from applying to one half of these
14 highway user revenues the ratio that, as of December 1 of the preceding calendar year,
15 the total mileage of county roads in the county bears to the total mileage of county
16 roads in all of the counties; and

17 (2) The amount that results from applying to one half of these
18 highway user revenues the ratio that, as of December 1 of the preceding calendar year,
19 the total number of motor vehicles registered to owners having addresses in the county
20 bears to the total number of motor vehicles registered to owners in all the counties.

21 (c) The allocation of highway user revenues to a county under subsection (b)
22 of this section may not be less than the amount allocated to the county from highway
23 user revenue sources in the fiscal year that began July 1, 1967.

24 (d) From each county's share of highway user revenues determined under
25 this section, the Administration shall deduct the amount of highway user revenues
26 allocated to any municipality in the county under § 8–405 of this subtitle. The
27 resulting amount is the county's net share of highway user revenues.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

29 (a) No provision of law may be construed as prohibiting Calvert County from:

1 (1) Accepting an easement for public travel on a highway in a special
2 taxing district in the county;

3 (2) For the calculation of the allocation of highway user revenues to
4 the county under § 8–404 of the Transportation Article, including in the county’s
5 inventory of county roads any highway in a special taxing district in the county; or

6 (3) Distributing a portion of the county’s highway user revenues to a
7 special taxing district in the county.

8 (b) A highway under subsection (a) of this section includes a gravel road.

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

10 (a) It is the intent of the General Assembly that Calvert County:

11 (1) Accept an easement for public travel on highways in all special
12 taxing districts in the county;

13 (2) For the calculation of the allocation of highway user revenues to
14 the county under § 8–404 of the Transportation Article, include in the county’s
15 inventory of county roads all highways in all special taxing districts in the county; and

16 (3) Distribute a portion of the county’s highway user revenues to all
17 special taxing districts in the county.

18 (b) A highway under subsection (a) of this section includes a gravel road.

19 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 June 1, 2007.
