18 (K) IF A PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL 19 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT IS COMPLETED AT A COST LOWER THAN THE TOTAL 20 COST APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE PROJECT OR 21 IMPROVEMENT, THE BALANCE OF THE MAXIMUM STATE CONSTRUCTION
