## 2 Marriage - Performance of Ceremony - Retired Clerk of Court

- FOR the purpose of authorizing a retired clerk of the circuit court of a county to perform a marriage ceremony in this State; authorizing the county administrative judge of the circuit court to designate when and where the retired clerk may perform a marriage ceremony and the form of marriage ceremony to be recited by the retired clerk; and generally relating to marriage ceremonies.

1 2	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
3	Article - Family Law
4	2–101.
5	(a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
6	(c) "Clerk" means a clerk of the circuit court for a county.
7	2–406.
8	(a) (2) A marriage ceremony may be performed in this State by:
9 10	(i) any official of a religious order or body authorized by the rules and customs of that order or body to perform a marriage ceremony;
11	(ii) any clerk <b>OR RETIRED CLERK</b> ;
12 13	(iii) any deputy clerk designated by the county administrative judge of the circuit court for the county; or
14	(iv) a judge.
15 16	(f) The county administrative judge of the circuit court for the county shall designate:
17 18	(1) when and where the clerk, <b>RETIRED CLERK</b> , or deputy clerk may perform a marriage ceremony; and
19 20	(2) the form of the marriage ceremony to be recited by the clerk <b>RETIRED CLERK</b> , or deputy clerk and the parties being married.
21 22	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
