### **Rent Control - Local Government Preemption**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a local government from enacting, maintaining, or 4 enforcing a law, ordinance, or regulation that is designed to control the amount 5 of rent charged for leasing private residential or commercial property; providing that this Act does not impair the right of a local government to control 6 7 residential property in which the local government has a property interest; 8 repealing certain provisions of law authorizing Frederick County and 9 Washington County to control the increase of rent; defining a certain term; and 10 generally relating to the preemption of rent control by a local government.

#### **Article - Real Property**

- 2 **8–119.**
- 3 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "LOCAL GOVERNMENT" MEANS A COUNTY, 4 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE.
- 5 (B) A LOCAL GOVERNMENT MAY NOT ENACT, MAINTAIN, OR ENFORCE A
  6 LAW, ORDINANCE, OR REGULATION THAT IS DESIGNED TO CONTROL THE
  7 AMOUNT OF RENT CHARGED FOR LEASING PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL OR
  8 COMMERCIAL PROPERTY.
- 9 (C) THIS SECTION DOES NOT IMPAIR THE RIGHT OF A LOCAL GOVERNMENT TO MANAGE AND CONTROL RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY IN WHICH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT HAS A PROPERTY INTEREST.
