4 5	(b) The following persons are not required to obtain a license under this section:
6	(1) A person licensed by the Department to catch finfish for sale;
7 8	(2) A retail market, restaurant, or other establishment where finfish are sold or served to ultimate consumers, and not for resale;
9	(3) A person who buys finfish for personal use or consumption; and
10 11	(4) A person who catches and sells as bait finfish species defined as bait under subsection (c) of this section.
12 13	(c) The Department shall adopt regulations defining which species of finfish may be caught and sold as bait under subsection (b)(4) of this section.
14 15 16	(D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO DEFINE THE SPECIES THAT ARE INCLUDED AS SHELLFISH UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
