A PERSON MAY NOT DISPLAY ON A MOTOR VEHICLE ANY MODEL, SIGN,
 STICKER, OR OTHER ITEM THAT DEPICTS OR RESEMBLES ANATOMICALLY
 CORRECT, LESS THAN COMPLETELY AND OPAQUELY COVERED, HUMAN OR
 ANIMAL GENITALS, HUMAN BUTTOCKS, OR HUMAN FEMALE BREASTS.

6 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any person convicted of a 7 misdemeanor for the violation of any of the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law is 8 subject to a fine of not more than \$500.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2007.
