- 7 (1) shall remain registered when the voter moves to another county in 8 the State; and
- 9 (2) may not be required to register again unless the voter's registration is canceled in accordance with Subtitle 5 of this title.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
