- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 3 PERMIT, OR PROHIBIT THE CATCHING, POSSESSING, PURCHASING,
- 4 TRANSPORTING, OR EXPORTING OF SNAPPING TURTLES.

- 6 (a) [The Department shall prescribe by rules and regulations the methods to catch snapping turtles.
- 8 (b)] A person may not catch or attempt to catch snapping turtles in the 9 tributary waters of Charles County from April 15 to May 31, inclusive. A person may 10 not use hook and line and trotline to catch snapping turtles in these waters.
- 11 **[(c)] (B)** The Department may not prohibit the use of turtle pots in areas where nets are prohibited.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
