HOUSE BILL 1223

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO RESTRICT, 6 PERMIT, OR PROHIBIT THE CATCHING, POSSESSING, PURCHASING, 7 TRANSPORTING, OR EXPORTING OF SNAPPING TURTLES.

8 4–738.

9 (a) [The Department shall prescribe by rules and regulations the methods to 10 catch snapping turtles.

11 (b)] A person may not catch or attempt to catch snapping turtles in the 12 tributary waters of Charles County from April 15 to May 31, inclusive. A person may 13 not use hook and line and trotline to catch snapping turtles in these waters.

14 [(c)] (B) The Department may not prohibit the use of turtle pots in areas 15 where nets are prohibited.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 July 1, 2007.
