Agriculture - Confinement of Pigs During Pregnancy

 separate offense; and generally relating to the prohibition against tethering or
 confining a pregnant pig.

"FARM" MEANS THE LAND, BUILDING, SUPPORT FACILITIES, (2) 1 AND OTHER EQUIPMENT THAT IS WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY USED FOR THE 2 PRODUCTION OF ANIMALS FOR FOOD OR FIBER. 3 4 (3) "PIG" MEANS ANY ANIMAL OF THE PORCINE SPECIES. 3 (D) (1) A PERSON THAT IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF THIS 4 SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT 5 FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS, OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000, OR BOTH.

6 (2) EACH INSTANCE OF TETHERING OR CONFINING A SINGLE PIG
 7 IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION CONSTITUTES A SEPARATE OFFENSE.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2007.
